Aug 24th 2339: Staff Officer, S.W. Sub Area; by telephone; "ALLENBY T.A." Acknowledge – writing.

Aug 25th 0130: Guard on Drill Hall posted; two sentries relieved each hour. 1015: S.W. Sub Area telegram from U.S.T.E.D. reference LDQ 1. 23.8.9. Programme of issue of stores from Ordnance Stores begins 1200 hrs. 25.8.9

Aug 27th 1145: Bde. Major phoned; orders expected shortly giving authority to call up sufficient T.A. personnel to man all initial guards and V.Ps., including those provided for in the London Area. Bounty will be payable to all T.A. ORs. so called up. Volunteers to be obtained as far

as possible.

1215: London District S.W. Sub Area phoned; can we call up one Officer and 50 ORs. to man V.Ps. in London Area. Allotment of troops and orders for manning V.Ps. to follow shortly; - told yes.

Aug 28th

1135: Bde. Major rang asking how we were getting on; told that all men with exception of two had reported, and that Chertsey V.P. was to be taken over at 1430 hrs, and Kew and Richmond at 1900 hrs.

B.M. ordered that V.P. must be in telephonic communication with Bn. H.Q. Telephone orderly must stick by nearest civil telephone.

Telephone numbers of V.Ps. must be reported to Bde. H.Q. Report to Bde. when guards are posted and tell them what feeding

arrangements have been made. 1430: Guard at V.P. 33 reported posted; feeding by Wade, telephone number Chertsey 2126.

1450: Telephone message from 132 Bde. from 44th Div. H.Q. You are authorised to embody forthwith sufficient T.A. personnel (volunteers if possible) to guard all V.Ps. vide appendix EHDS including those in London area. V.Ps. being guarded by Regulars and Militia taken over first. Guards will not be provided for any V.P. for which N.D.C. personnel will be available by 1000 hrs on 29.8.9. Militia guards on relief will return to depots or units. All personnel so called up will be given £5 bounty if enlisted before 0000 hrs on 24/25 August. 132 Inf. Bde. will include V.P. 66; strength 1 Officer 2 N.C.Os. and 30 ORs. Please acknowledge and report as each V.P. is taken over. Reported.

1735: Staff Capt. 132 Bde. by phone; call up as quickly as possible 11 Officers, 42 N.C.Os., 234 men. Adjutant to report to Bde. forthwith.

1740: C.O. to 1/6th. Reporting 1735 message.

1746: Message from Bde H.Q. Call up 14 Officers, 70 N.C.Os. 401 men. Reporting to Bde. H.Q. - impossible – numbers not available. Suggested calling up whole Bn. and they agreed.

1800: "A" Coy. instructed by phone to call up all personnel; other Coys. instructed verbally.

1905: Guard Commander at L.A. V.P. 10 reported guard posted; feeding by relays at Lyons. Telephone Richmond 0775.

Arrangements to be made to take over the following guard from R.N. 24 Admiralty Oil and Fuelling Station Medway. 1 Officer, 6 N.C.Os., 45 Privates. 1430: "A" Coy. left Drill Hall. 1530: "B" Coy. left Drill Hall. 1600: "D" Coy. left Drill Hall. 1630: H.Q. Coy. left Drill Hall. 2045: Capt. Pullman reported all personnel arrived safely, taken on to various V.Ps. and all in process of taking over. Transport was returning to R.V. and he was remaining at R.V. for one hour more, and

then proceeding to post taken over by 2/Lt. Collins. He advised C.O.
