- Dec 4th Promotions: Capt. F.H.S. Palmer and Capt. H.E.P. Spearing granted unpaid acting rank of Major, and granted the pay of acting rank of Major w.e.f. same date. Lt. G.L.A. Squire, Lt. G.B. Shaw, Lt. N.F. Tannock granted unpaid acting rank of Captain, and granted the pay of acting rank of Captain w.e.f. same date. Authority Appendix 12th Div. Orders dated 2/12/39 Serial 6.
- Dec 5th V.P. 40 relieved by 67th A.T. Regt.
- Dec 9th 104 immatures and Conducting Party left for Aylsham, Norfolk, and were posted to 65th Searchlight Regt.
- Dec 11th 4 Officers and 20 ORs. proceeded to I.T.C. Kingston Barracks for fitting out prior to proceeding overseas.
